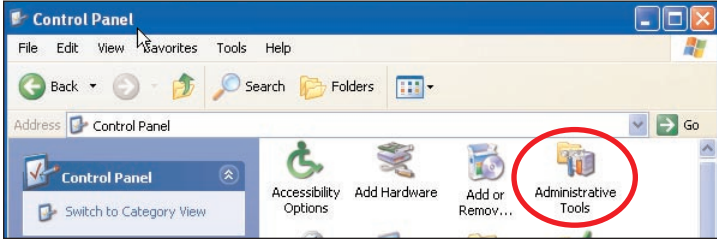


Hard Drive Addendum

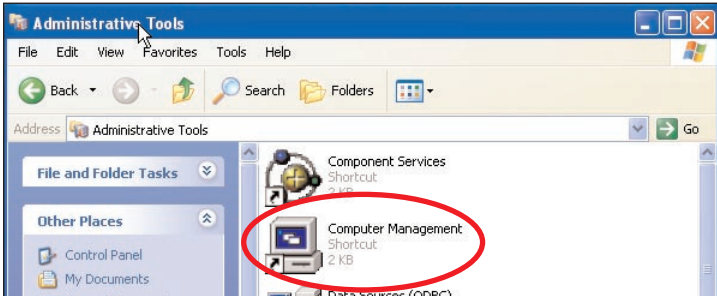
Formatting your netDrives Drive for Windows XP

Your new Glyph drive has been formatted for the Mac. To use the drive with your Windows system, you'll need to format your hard disk for Windows.

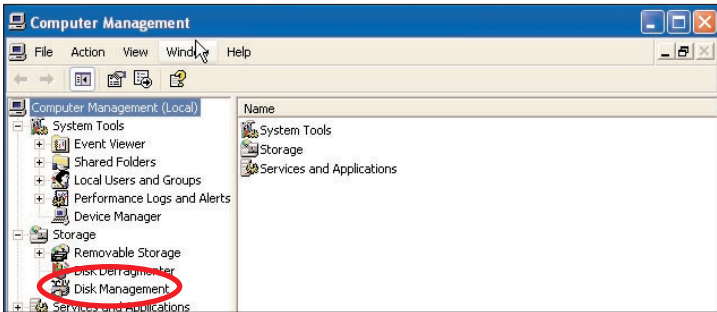
1. Open your Control Panel and click Administrative Tools.



2. Click Computer Management

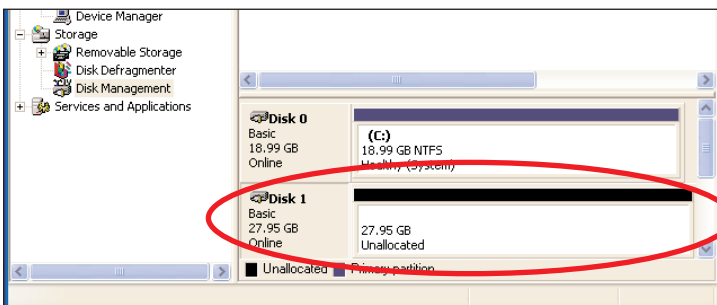


3. Click Disk Management

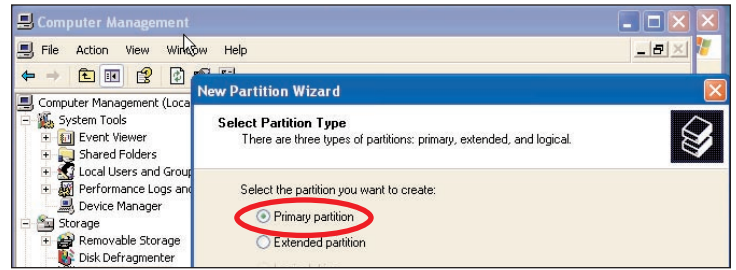


4. The wizard will pop up here to help - click cancel here.

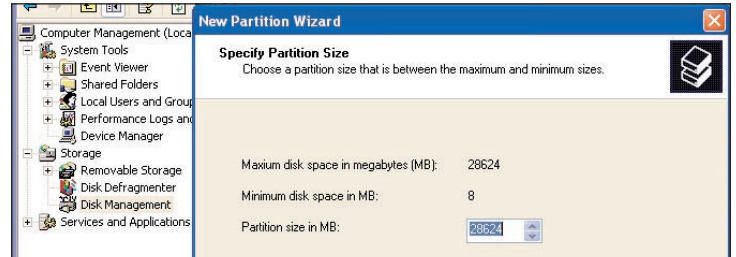
5. The drive should show up in the right hand side of the screen and could be designated Disk 1, depending on how many drives you already have.



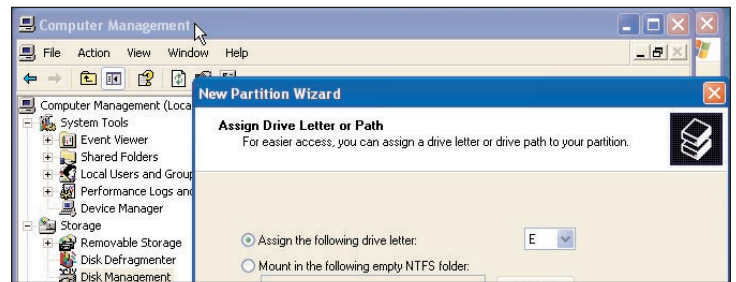
6. Right click on Disk 1 and choose Initialize.
The wizard should pop up again - choose Primary Partition.



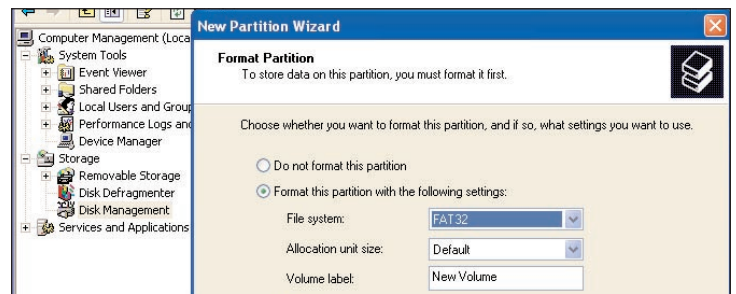
7. Next choose the partition size - select the maximum amount if you only want one.



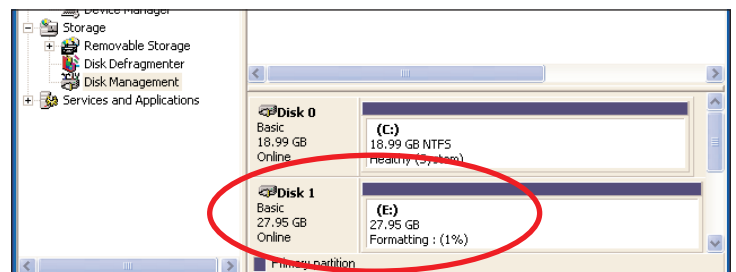
8. Assign drive letter.



9. Next choose Fat32 or NTFS (Fat32 will show up on PC running 98, ME, etc. NTFS will only work on 2000 & XP



10. Drive formatting...
