


# Transfuser 1.0 Plug-in

This Read Me documents known issues and workarounds with the Digidesign Transfuser Plug-in.

## Known Issues

### **Pro Tools Crashes the First Time You Insert Transfuser on a Track (Issue #101627)**

After installing Transfuser or manually deleting the DAE preferences, Pro Tools crashes after the first time Transfuser is inserted on a track. This occurs only if particular untested or unqualified third party plug-ins (such as Massey plug-ins) are also in the Plug-ins folder.

### **When Using “Save Copy In” Command, Transfuser Does Not Link User Audio Files in the Session Copy (Issue #102852) (Mac OS X Only)**

When opening a new session copy, Transfuser may indicate that audio files are not linked. The unlinked audio files must be manually relinked by creating a copy of the session located in a destination folder other than the original session’s parent folder.

**To avoid this problem when saving a session copy, do the following:**

- 1 Choose File > Save Copy In.
- 2 In the Save Copy In dialog, choose a destination other than the same parent session folder as the original session.
- 3 Ensure that the All Audio Files option is not selected.
- 4 Click Save.
- 5 Close the current session.

### **Overwriting an Existing Transfuser Track with the Same File from Another Folder Causes the File to Be Deleted from the Project Browser (Issue #104244)**

When keeping two identical copies of the same audio file in different locations and loading one of them into a Transfuser drum pad, it will be displayed in the Project browser. When this sample is replaced by the copy from the other location, the sample disappears from the Project browser instead of updating the Project browser entry with the new file path.

### **When Deleting or Removing a File from the Project Browser, the File Is Not Unloaded from Transfuser (Issue #104162)**

When deleting or removing a file from the Project browser, the file still loads in Transfuser but does not appear in the Project browser after saving, closing, and re-opening a session. The audio file no longer appears in the Project browser but still loads in Transfuser.

**When Clearing and Deleting a File from the Region List that Is also Used in Transfuser, the File Is Not Unloaded from Transfuser (Issue #104128)**

**(Mac OS X Only)**

When dragging a mono audio file to both Transfuser and the Pro Tools Timeline, and then clearing and deleting the region from the Region List, the region is cleared from the Region List and deleted from the file system. However, the region is not unloaded from Transfuser. After saving, closing, and reopening the session, the cleared and deleted audio file mistakenly appears as an unlinked file in Transfuser.

**Overwriting Converted Files in Transfuser Clears Files from Region List (Issue #104053)**

When dragging an MP3 file into the Region List, it is converted into a WAV file. Dragging this WAV file from the Region List into Transfuser to create a track, then dragging a different audio file from the Desktop on to the Phrase Synth Waveform display, and then dragging the WAV file from the Region List onto a Pro Tools audio track results in an empty region on the audio track. Also, the region name appears in italics in the Region List.

**When Dragging Files from the Region List or Workspace Browser, the Drum Sequencer and Slice Sequencer Editors Are Not Updated (Issue #104054)**

When dragging an audio file from the Region List or the Workspace browser to a Synth module, the Drum Sequencer and Slice Sequencer Editors are not updated to show the new audio file.

**If a Mono Audio File Is Dragged into Transfuser and into Pro Tools, this File Is Not Copied into the Session Audio Folder (Issue #101622)**

**(Windows Only)**

When a mono audio file is dragged into Transfuser and also onto a Pro Tools audio track, the file appears in the Sampler Files folder in the Project browser but not in the session's Audio Files folder. If the audio track is then deleted, the Region List is cleared without a warning that this file is still in use in Transfuser. The Project browser is then out of sync with Transfuser.

If the file is unloaded from Transfuser, it will be removed from the Sampler Files folder in the Project browser but still be shown in the Region List. The Region List is then out of sync with the Project browser.

**Adding Files from Transfer Volumes to Transfuser References Original Files on Transfer Volumes (Issue #104628)**

When adding a file from a Transfer Volume such as a USB drive or a network, Pro Tools opens a dialog asking where to save a copy of the sample. Regardless of whether the dialog is cancelled or not, Transfuser always references the original file on the Transfer Volume. The Project browser will show the chosen location, although it is no longer referenced.

**An Audio File Dragged from Transfuser's Audio Files Folder onto a Pro Tools Track Is Not Converted to that Pro Tools Session's Bit Depth (Issue #101629)**

When dragging an audio file from Transfuser's Audio Files Folders onto a track in a Pro Tools session that has a different bit depth from the imported Transfuser audio file, the audio file is not converted to that Pro Tools session's bit depth.

If, for example, a Pro Tools session is set to 16-bit, a 24-bit audio file can still be loaded into Transfuser. The 24-bit audio file will appear in the Project browser. Dragging this file from the Project browser onto a Pro Tools audio track and then playing them results in a loud noise, because the audio file has not been converted to 16-bit.

**The Pencil Changes to Brush Tool Only After Mouse Is Moved or Clicked While Holding the Shift Key (Issue #102678)**

In the Slicer Sequencer Editor, the Pencil tool will change to the Brush tool only after the mouse is moved or clicked while holding the Shift key.

**Play Button Flickers When Assigned to a Fader (Issue #104246)**

When the Play button is assigned to a MIDI fader, moving the fader causes the Play button to flicker.

**Factory Tracks Folder Not Highlighted When Browsing to Previous Folder (Issue #103747)**

When browsing into a Factory Tracks folder and then returning to the previous folder level, the previous folder is not highlighted.

**When Dragging Audio onto any Synth Module, the Destination Module Does Not Highlight (Issue #104438)**

When dragging audio from the Recorder, or Slicer or Phrase or Synth module editors to another Synth module, the destination synth module does not become highlighted.

**The Drum Pattern Editor Menu Buttons (Select, Edit) Highlight Randomly (Issue #104148)**

**(Mac OS X Only)**

The Drum Pattern editor menu buttons (Select, Edit) highlight randomly after clicking.

**Pro Tools May Crash When Simplified-Chinese Characters Are Used in User Account Names or Settings File Names (Issue #102525)**

On simplified-Chinese systems, Pro Tools may crash if User account names or Settings file names contain simplified-Chinese characters.

**When Loading a Preset in the Edit and Master Section, Simplified-Chinese Characters Become Transparent (Issue #102530)**

After loading any file containing simplified-Chinese characters in the file name, characters in the file-dialog become difficult to read.

**Cosmetic Issue in Audio Import Menu (Issue #104254)**

After dragging an audio file into Transfuser, the boxes around the description and the OK and Cancel buttons are darker than the rest of the window when the Import menu appears.

**Cosmetic Issue While Scrolling (Issue #104049)**

**(Windows Only)**

When dragging a sample from a Drum Pad to another Transfuser Track such that downward scrolling occurs, when reaching the last track it is not possible to scroll up again. The destination module will also not be highlighted.

**Cosmetic Issue on M.A.R.I.O. Apply Button (Issue #102952)**

**(Windows Only)**

Graphic artifacts sometimes occur when the M.A.R.I.O. Apply button is clicked repeatedly.
