


Double and Triple Stroke Roll Developer

The purpose of the following exercise is to produce a great quality of sound from both right and left hands while working to achieve a very open quality to your rolls. While you are working on these exercises you should always use a metronome. I also suggest that you record yourself so that you can identify both your strengths and areas that need improvement. Always strive for a consistent sound from every stroke. Good luck and remember "It's always about your Quality of Sound."
