

PIGTRONIX ARIA - USER'S GUIDE

Welcome to the realm of Pigtronix!

Your new Aria is a versatile analog overdrive pedal that provides a broad range of expressive and touch-sensitive diode clipping distortion sounds. In addition to this dynamic and powerful breakup, the Aria is capable of intense filtering effects by virtue of its three, 12db / octave graphic EQs. These active stages have the ability to drastically change the timbre of the distortion created by the Aria. When all three EQ knobs (Lo / Mid / High) are set to 12:00, the frequency response is flat, retaining the natural tone of the instrument. By turning up the Lo knob (clockwise), the low frequencies in the audio signal will be boosted. By turning down the Lo knob (counter-clockwise), the low frequencies in the audio signal will be attenuated. The Mid and High knobs work the same way. These EQs have been carefully tuned to provide a wide palette of tones, enabling you to hit that sweet spot everytime.

DC Power - The Aria comes with a 18VDC @ 300mA neg. tip power supply. It will sound slightly different but will also work just fine on a standard Boss style 9VDC power supply. The Aria does not take batteries.

The Aria will play nice with other distortion pedals, so make sure to try placing the Aria both before and after your other gain boxes to see which configuration provides the best tone for you.

In keeping with Pigtronix tradition. The controls on the Aria pedal have been tuned to provide the fattest possible tone and widest range of musical possibilities.
