How to Tune Your Ukulele




The standard tuning is GCEA. Here is a picture shows you what each string's note is.

The easiest way to tune your ukulele is to use a electronic Tuner. Use the image to understand what the notes are for each string. So pluck a string on the ukulele and tweak the tuning pegs on it until the dial hovers over the correct note on the electronic tuner. Do this with each of the strings.

Tones and Semitones




B to C is a semitone. E to F is a semitone.
Twice a semitone is a tone. F to G is a tone.







Strum Patterns




Basic 4 Chords Progression Rhythm




