What is the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter, and what are its key benefits?

Key customer benefits:

- Connects wirelessly to your smartphone, tablet or other *Bluetooth* enabled device so you can enjoy high-quality music when connected to a Bose sound system.
- Simple pairing process with no software and no network configuration necessary.
- Multi-device pairing and connection. Pairs with up to eight *Bluetooth* enabled devices and maintains active connection with up to three for easy switching between devices for a more dynamic music listening experience.

What technologies are used in the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter includes the following technologies:

- *Bluetooth* 4.0 technology with A2DP audio streaming.
- aptX® technology.

Which cables are included with the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter includes an optical cable, 3.5mm audio cable, a 3.5mm female-to-RCA cable and a USB-to-USB micro-B cable for power.

What are the audio output connection options for the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter has two audio output connections: optical and headphone jack (3.5mm analog out).

Does the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter support Wi-Fi® or WiDi® technology?

No. The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter wireless connection is Bluetooth only.

What is the range of Bluetooth performance for the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter Bluetooth link is capable of stable operation at up to 30 feet (10 meters). Performance can be affected by obstacles such as walls or metal, interference from Wi-Fi® networks or other wireless devices, and device manufacturers' Bluetooth® implementations.

How many devices can pair with the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter at once?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter keeps track of the last eight devices to have paired and connected with it, dropping the least recently used when a new one is paired.

How many devices can connect with the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter at once?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter enables an active connection with up to three mobile devices for easy switching back and forth between three source devices without having to disconnect/reconnect.

What happens when my phone is streaming music to the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter and a call comes in?

When a call comes in, the audio on the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter will pause, and the call will come in through the phone itself. When the call is terminated, music playback will resume. Some details of this experience will vary depending on the implementation by the phone manufacturer.

What is the purpose of the micro-B USB port on the back of the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter uses a micro-B USB cable for powering the unit and for future software updates. It does not receive audio through this interface.

How much does the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter weigh?

The Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter weighs 0.15 lbs. (.07 kg).

What are the dimensions of the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter?

The dimensions of the Bose® Bluetooth® Audio adapter are 2.4"W x 2.4"D x 1"H (6.1 cm x 6.1 cm x 2.54cm).
