
SL 4 FEATURE AND PERFORMANCE ENHANCEMENTS

- Supports four turntables or CD decks switchable in any combination.
- Two high-speed USB 2.0 ports for two DJs for uninterrupted performances.
- Aux Input for session recording or LiveFeed.
- Aux Output assignable to the SP-6 Sample Player.
- Four software-switchable analog Thru connections for regular vinyl/CD.
- 48 kHz and 96 kHz sample rate switch on the SL 4 rear.
- 10-in 10-out USB sound card with any software supporting ASIO or Core Audio.
- Bus power from either USB port or the included external power supply.
- Includes four control records, four CDs, two USB and six RCA cables.



The SL 4 is the first standalone DJ interface with two USB ports for seamless DJ changeover and back-to-back performances. Superior sound is delivered with high quality 96 kHz, 24-bit audio. Built-in galvanic isolation between USB and audio, with turn on/off muting, ensures that only the purest interference-free audio signal is heard. Low-latency ASIO and Core Audio drivers allow you to use the SL 4 as a studio production tool with multiple third-party software applications. The SL 4 is masterfully crafted by Rane for the discerning DJ.

These included drivers allow the SL 4 to act as a 10-in 10-out USB external sound card for use with multiple third-party software clients supporting Core Audio (Mac) or ASIO (Windows).

Serato Control Vinyl and Control CD

The Serato Control Vinyl and Control CDs each contain the Noise Map Control Tone, a unique control signal which allows Scratch Live to track the motion of the record, simulating the same movement with digital audio.

Serato Approved USB Controllers (optional)

Serato has certified a select range of new generation controllers with USB connectivity to Scratch Live. This means that Scratch Live can now send track information from the software to the supported hardware on-board displays.
